



Free Crochet Pattern – Farmhouse Granny Square

Free Crochet Pattern Farmhouse Granny Square | © loopy & lit, 2026

Materials

Yarn: Yarnsmiths Create DK

- approx. 7.5 g / 22 m (24 yards) in total

Colours:

Colour A – Cream (3050)

Colour B – Oatmeal (3064)

Colour C – Pale Lilac (3340)

Hook size: 5.0 mm

Yarn needle

Scissors

Finished Size

Approx. 14 cm (Height) x 14 cm (Width)

Stitch Abbreviations (US Terms)

ch: chain

st: stitch

sc: single crochet

dc: double crochet

sl st: slip stitch

(number): stitch count at end of row

2 dc / 3 dc cluster stitches:

Yarn over and insert your hook into the stitch. Yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through 2 loops. Stop and leave the dc unfinished.

Repeat the steps above 1 or 2 more times **in same stitch**, and you'll have 2 or 3 unfinished dc. Yarn over and pull through all loops.

Notes

- Skill Level: Beginner
- Video tutorial is included to guide you through the steps.
- This square pattern is crocheted from the centre outwards.
- Stitch counts (includes sc and dc) are listed at the end of each row. Chain spaces are listed separately where applicable.
- Size can be adjusted by adding or reducing rounds.
- This pattern uses 100% acrylic DK yarns, other brands with similar specifications also work.

Instructions

Start with a magic ring.

Round 1:

Colour A

Ch 2 (as 1 unfinished dc) and 2 dc cluster st into the magic ring.

[Ch 2, 3 dc cluster st into the magic ring] 7 more times. Ch 2. Pull the yarn tail to close the ring.

Sl st in top of the first cluster st. **(8 clusters, 8 ch 2 spaces)** Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Round 2:

Colour B – attach new yarn with sl st in any ch 2 space.

Ch 2 (as 1 dc) and 2 dc in same ch 2 space.

[Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in next ch 2 space. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch 2 space.] 3 more times.

Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in last ch 2 space. Ch 1.

Sl st in second ch of the beginning ch 2. **(12 dc, 8 clusters, 8 ch 1 spaces, 4 ch 2 corner spaces)**

Round 3:

Ch 2 (as 1 dc). Dc in next 2 sts and ch 1 space.

[Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in next ch 2 space. Ch 1. Dc in next ch 1 space, next 3 sts. and next ch 1 space.] 3 more times.

Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in last ch 2 space. Ch 1. Dc in last ch 1 space.

Sl st in second ch of the beginning ch 2. **(20 dc, 8 clusters, 8 ch 1 spaces, 4 ch 2 corner spaces)**

Round 4:

Ch 2 (as 1 dc). Dc in next 3 sts and ch 1 space.

[Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in next ch 2 space. Ch 1. Dc in next ch 1 space, next 5 sts, and next ch 1 space.] 3 more times.

Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in last ch 2 space. Ch 1. Dc in last ch 1 space. Dc in last st.

Sl st in second ch of the beginning ch 2. **(28 dc, 8 clusters, 8 ch 1 spaces, 4 ch 2 corner spaces)**

Round 5:

Ch 2 (as 1 dc). Dc in next 4 sts and ch 1 space.

[Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in next ch 2 space. Ch 1. Dc in next ch 1 space, next 7 sts, and next ch 1 space.] 3 more times.

Ch 1. (3 dc cluster, ch 2, 3 dc cluster) in last ch 2 space. Ch 1. Dc in last ch 1 space. Dc in last 2 sts.

Sl st in second ch of the beginning ch 2. **(36 dc, 8 clusters, 8 ch 1 spaces, 4 ch 2 corner spaces)**

Ch 1. Cut the yarn and fasten off.

NOTES: You can adjust the size of the square by stopping after Round 4 or adding more rounds after Round 5. Simply follow the steps. 8 dc will be added in each round accordingly.

Round 6 – Lace Edge:

Colour C – tie a slip knot, attach new yarn with sl st in any ch 1 space after a corner.

[Ch 3, skip 1 st, and sl st in next st.] 4 times. Ch 3, skip 1 st, and sl st in next ch 1 space.

Ch 3, and sl st in next ch 2 corner space. Ch 4. Sl st in same space. Ch 3, and sl st in next ch 1 space.

Repeat the steps above 3 more times.

After finishing the edge in last corner, ch 3, and sl st in the joining sl st where you attach new yarn.

(28 ch 3 spaces, 4 ch 4 spaces)

Ch 1. Cut the yarn and fasten off. Weave in ends.
